Biodegradable waste

It is composed of green waste and kitchen waste.

What you can put in:

kitchen residues, meat, fish, fruit and vegetables, dried fruits shells, egg shells, fish bones, cut flowers and the pot plants (small quantities), farinaceous products, coffee grounds and tea filters, spoiled and expired food, corks, toothpicks, wooden ice cream sticks, horse biodegradable bags, ash and sawdust (small quantities).

Plastic packaging

Plastic packaging is plastic or polystyrene packaging (foam) that is wrapped around the products we buy.

What you can put in:

empty plastic bottles, plastic caps, flacons (shampoo, detergents, plastic household and toiletry bottles), disposable plates and cups, plastic film or wrappers for food, food pots and trays (for sauces, creams, yogurt) blisters, styrofoam bowls, small pots, jerry cans which did not contain hazardous liquids, pluriball, cellophane, clothes hangers.

Not recyclable waste

The not recyclable waste is the part of our rubbish that cannot be recycled, i.e. the part that remains after recycling.

What you can put in:

stationery, paper soiled with detergents, rubber objects, carbon paper, plastic paper, wax paper, glass paper, thermal paper, cosmetics, patches, cotton wool, toothpaste tubes and toothbrushes, tampons, toys, goggles and contact lenses, jewellery, lighters, cigarettes butts, candles, video/audiotapes, cd and dvd in their cases, disposable razors, umbrellas, dirty rags, adhesive tapes, sponges, foam rubber, stockings, artificial flowers, disposable plastic cutlery, collant, chewing gum, shells (molluscs), lamps.

Paper and cardboard

What you can put in:

juice and food tetrapak cartons, pizza boxes, tissue paper, used paper napkins, newspapers, books and notebooks, paper sheets, boxes, paper bags, cardboard packaging, receipts.

Mixed glass bottles and cans

What you can put in:

drinking glasses, glass bottles, pitchers, jars, tin cans and trays.

Collection schedule: place your bin outside for collection from 21:00 to 24:00 the evening before collection day, near your house, by the public street.
